Brevard Family Partnership (formerly Community Based Care of Brevard) needs your help to provide care and support for

the thousands of children in Brevard who, each year, suffer abuse and neglect.

As the lead child welfare agency on the Space Coast, it is our mission to protect children, strengthen families and change lives. We do this through the prevention of child abuse and the operation and management of a community-based system of care for abused, abandoned and neglected children and their families that is family centered, strength-based and community driven.

Working with over 70 community partners and providers, including Devereux and Children's Home Society, Brevard Family Partnership provides the resources to increase prevention and early intervention services with the purpose of strengthening and preserving the integrity of the family while protecting the children.



A program as unique as the Space Coast

Brevard C.A.R.E.S. (Coordination, Advocacy, Resources, Education, Support) is Brevard Family Partnership's signature, primary, voluntary prevention program tailored to protect children, strengthen families and change lives. Brevard C.A.R.E.S. offers a full-array of support services and wraparound-family team conferencing to families experiencing stressors that often lead to abuse and neglect. The success of this program is due to the proactive participation of the families in need.

Through Brevard C.A.R.E.S. we have reduced the number of children placed in out-of-home care from over 1,500 to less than 500.

A loving home, a caring heart. Foster parenting and child adoptions

Have you ever thought of opening your home and your heart to a child in need? Consider becoming a foster or adoptive parent. Though we do everything in our power to ensure that families stay together sometimes there is no alternative. In certain circumstances a child must be removed from their home for their own health and safety.

As a foster parent you provide the necessary, temporary safety and security a child needs while their situation at home is improved to the point that they may return.

While most children will return home to their parents, many still will become available for adoption. Providing a "forever home" to a child could mean the difference between a life of fear and desperation or hope and prosperity.

These children represent all races and ethnicities and range in age from birth to 17. Their personalities are as different as the sand on the beach and each as beautiful!

Your family and home life are important and we want to ensure children needing foster care or who are available for adoption are matched with you as the foster or adoptive parents. We also provide financial and services support to help you in your care of a child.
